- ▷ Professional experience in a number of recent (and not so recent) JavaScript frontend frameworks including Svelte, Angular and Knockout. I am also comfortable working with Vanilla JS.
- ▷ Well acquainted with server-side maintenance tasks including running NGINX, Bash scripting, writing Systemd units and managing cron jobs. High level of familiarity with Linux.
- ▷ Well-versed in modern and emerging HTML5 and CSS functionality, including Web Components and media queries (responsive design). Familiar with CSS frameworks including Bootstrap, Foundation and Bulma.
- ▷ Proficient in the design, creation and querying of relational database schemas using database engines such as MySQL, PostgreSQL and SQLite. Experience with NoSQL databases including CouchDB, MongoDB and Redis.
- ▷ Confident using Node.js tooling such as Gulp, Babel, Rollup and Sass for compiling and optimising frontend apps.
- ▷ I have wholeheartedly embraced test-driven development (TDD) and automated code linting. My preferred tools are RSpec and RuboCop in Ruby; and Mocha and ESLint in JavaScript. I also have some experience creating and running acceptance tests using browser automation frameworks such as Behat and Capybara.
- ▷ Experience writing CPU-intensive numerical analysis software for solving complex mathematical problems. I also have experience creating numerical and cartographic data visualisations for the web using D3.
- ▷ I have varying levels of experience in a number of other languages including PHP, Perl, Python, Java, C/C++ and MATLAB. I am currently learning Elixir.
- ▷ Familiar with most modern version control systems, Git in particular.
- ▷ Proficient in the use of the L^AT_EX type-setting language for writing technical documentation and academic material.
